

COMMUNITY SERVICE TAX CREDIT PROGRAM

If you pay taxes in Kansas and make a contribution of \$250 or more directly to an approved CSP Awardee, you may be eligible to receive 50% or 70% of your donation back in tax credits.



HOW DO TAX CREDITS WORK?

What are tax credits?

State tax credits reduce the total amount of taxes owed to the state. They are a way for a taxpayer to substantially reduce the cost of making a contribution to a charitable organization.

Who is eligible to receive a state tax credit?

Businesses and individuals subject to Kansas income tax are eligible to receive a tax credit through this program.

What are the benefits of tax credits?

Donating at least \$250 qualifies you for a state tax credit worth 50% or 70% of your total contribution (for example, a \$1,000 donation would be eligible for \$500 (50%) or \$700 (70%) in state tax credits).
